### **Shedden Sanitary Sewer Construction Update #25**

## Work Completed this week (Sept 08 -Sept 12):

- The contractor completed the installation of storm sewer c/w catch basins and storm services.
- Road construction with granular B, skiff of the granular A.
- Removal of broken sidewalk panels.
- Installation of a 200mm watermain crossing at the Union Road/Spicer Street intersection is completed.

# Work Planned for (Sept 15 - Sept 19):

- The curb stringline will be completed on Monday, and the installation will be completed in the second half of the following week.
- The watermain testing is scheduled on Monday, September 15, 2025. After testing is completed, the watermain tie-in will take place at Spicer Street.
- Topsoil placement on the boulevard and area of restoration.
- Road CBs and storm services reconnected to the new storm sewer installation progresses.

#### **Road Closure and Access:**

- Union Road is closed to through traffic from Talbot Line to Fingal Line. Detour signs are installed as per the detour plan.
- The detour is set east of Union Rd via John Wise Road.
- Local traffic has access to properties.
- A walking path for pedestrians is on the grass area East of the silt fence along Union Road.
- Access to the soccer field parking area and residences south of the work zone will be maintained from the south side of Union Road.
- Contractor built a temporary bypass road behind the properties east of Union Road, between Teetzel Street and Fairground Street. This road is reserved for emergency vehicles only.
- During construction works at the Union Road/Fairground Street intersection, all the emergency vehicles will be redirected to go through the Fairground Campus Parking area.
- The Union Road/Talbot Line intersection is open for traffic.
- The school bus pick-up and drop-off will be at the intersection of Talbot Lane and Union Road, maintaining the same locations used in June.
