# **Shedden Sanitary Sewer Construction Update #28**

#### Work Completed this week (Sept 28 -Oct 03):

- The paving subcontractor has commenced the application of surface asphalt (HL-3) over the previously laid base asphalt (HL-8) on all residential driveways.
- The contractor has finalized the placement of Granular 'A' material on the gravel shoulders and is currently distributing topsoil in preparation for hydroseeding and sod installation.
- The contractor continued parging and benching of the maintenance holes.

## Work Planned for (Oct 06 - Oct 10):

- The paving subcontractor is scheduled to complete the application of the surface asphalt (HL-3) on all driveways.
- The placement of topsoil will be finalized, and the contractor will then commence the installation of sod and hydroseeding.



- The required traffic signs will be installed as specified within the contract drawings.
- The pavement marking painting is scheduled to begin toward the end of next week.

#### **Road Closure and Access:**

- Union Road is closed to through traffic from Talbot Line to Fingal Line. Detour signs are installed as per the detour plan.
- The detour is set east of Union Rd via John Wise Road.
- Local traffic has access to properties.
- A walking path for pedestrians is on the grass area East of the silt fence along Union Road.
- Access to the soccer field parking area and residences south of the work zone will be maintained from the south side of Union Road.
- Contractor built a temporary bypass road behind the properties east of Union Road, between Teetzel Street and Fairground Street. This road is to be used only by emergency vehicles.
- During construction works at the Union Road/Fairground Street intersection, all emergency vehicles will be redirected to use the Fairground Campus Parking area.
- The Union Road/Talbot Line intersection is open for traffic.
- The school bus pick-up and drop-off will be at the intersection of Talbot Lane and Union Road, maintaining the same locations used in June.
