## Fingal Construction Update #13

### Work Completed this week (Apr 27-May 1):

#### Crew

- Installed the storm mainline up to Storm Maintenance Hole #37.
- Installed Storm Maintenance Hole #37.
- Began installing the forcemain from the ravine heading south on Union Road.
- Continued directional drilling sanitary forcemain on Union Road between McDiarmid Line and Talbot Line.



## Work Planned for (May 4 – May 8):

### Crew 1

- Continue installing the sanitary forcemain from the ravine toward the pumping station entrance.
- As construction progresses, residents may need to access their homes from either the north or south side of Union Road, depending on the work location.
- Watermain work includes tie-ins at Fowler and Lanark, cutting and capping the watermain at Union Road and Fingal Line, and connecting residents to the temporary watermain. Any water service disruptions will be communicated by the contractor at least 48 hours in advance.





### **Road Closure and Access:**

- Union road is closed to traffic from Talbot Line to Fingal Line. Detour signs are installed as per the detour plan.
- The detour is east of Union Road via John Wise Line.
- As the sanitary and storm sewers are installed, driveways will be temporarily impacted to accommodate new service connections. The contractor will make every reasonable effort to maintain access; however, some residents may experience restricted driveway access for up to a few days during work
- The Contractor will provide residents with 1-2 days' notice if temporary driveway access restrictions are required.
- Walking path for pedestrians is on the east side Union Road marked by construction fence.
- The school bus pick-up and drop-off have been communicated by the bus company to affected users.
- Residents are asked to park in their driveways whenever possible and leave sufficient room on the roadway for construction traffic.

### **Construction Safety:**

- Your safety is very important to us. Please respect the work zone
- Please use caution when using the road or sidewalks in the construction zone and obey directions from traffic control.
- Parents are asked to ensure children stay clear of the construction area and equipment. Children should not enter the work zone and should be accompanied by a parent or guardian when near the construction area.
