Fingal Construction Update #15

Work Completed this week (May 11 - May 15):

Crew

- Implemented a new slide rail system to stabilize trench walls for deep sewer installation, which is expected to improve construction efficiency.
- Began installing the sanitary mainline from sanitary maintenance hole SAMH124, progressing south toward Fingal Line.
- Continued backfilling the trench behind the mainline crew while advancing the slide rail system south as the mainline installation progresses.



Work Planned for (May 19 – May 22):

Crew

- Continue installing the sanitary mainline within the new slide rail trench system south of the pumping station toward Fingal Line.
- Install sanitary private drain stubs to the Town’s right-of-way limit for each property.
- Continue backfilling the trench behind the sanitary mainline crew as work progresses.





Road Closure and Access:

- Union road is closed to traffic from Talbot Line to Fingal Line. Detour signs are installed as per the detour plan.
- The detour is east of Union Road via John Wise Line.
- As the sanitary and storm sewers are installed, driveways will be temporarily impacted to accommodate new service connections. The contractor will make every reasonable effort to maintain access; however, some residents may experience restricted driveway access for up to a few days during work.
- The Contractor will provide residents with 1-2 days' notice if temporary driveway access restrictions are required.
- Walking path for pedestrians is on the east side Union Road marked by construction fence.
- The school bus pick-up and drop-off have been communicated by the bus company to affected users.
- Residents are asked to park in their driveways whenever possible and leave sufficient room on the roadway for construction traffic.

Construction Safety:

- Your safety is very important to us. Please respect the work zone.
- Please use caution when using the road or sidewalks in the construction zone and obey directions from traffic control.
- Parents are asked to ensure children stay clear of the construction area and equipment. Children should not enter the work zone and should be accompanied by a parent or guardian when near the construction area.
