

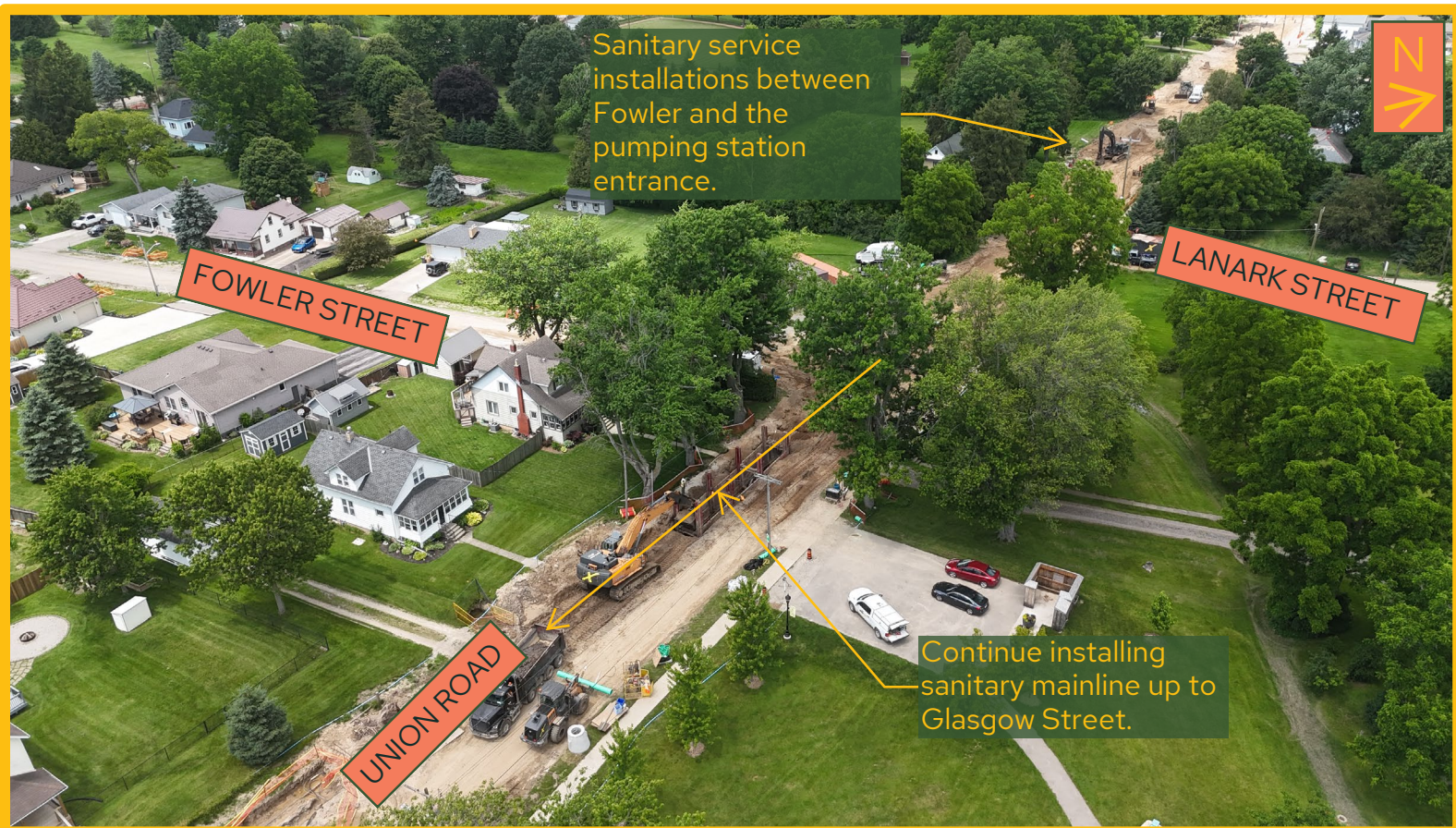

Fingal Construction Update #21

Work Completed this week (June 22nd – June 26th):

Crew

- Continued installing sanitary mainline on Union Road south of Fowler Street towards Glasgow Street.
- The second crew completed sanitary services, installing Private Drains up to property line between Fowler Street and the pumping station entrance.



Work Planned for (June 29th – July 3rd):

Crew

- The sanitary mainline crew will continue installing the sanitary sewer main to the intersection of Union Road and Glasgow Street and will install sanitary maintenance hole (SAMH120).
- Once SAMH120 has been installed at the Union Road and Glasgow Street intersection, the mainline crew will relocate to the pumping station entrance to begin installing the sanitary mainline toward the new pumping station.



Work Planned for (June 29th – July 3rd):

Second Crew:

- The second crew will complete the installation of sanitary services between Fowler Street and the pumping station entrance. Upon completion, they will move to the wastewater treatment plant early next week to install the forcemain from the west side of Union Road toward the treatment plant.
- Union Road will be fully closed just south of Corsley Park, residents located north of the pumping station will need to use McDiarmid Line to detour around both sites. A detour route will be put in place, please follow the detour.





Road Closure and Access:

- Union road is closed to traffic from Talbot Line to Fingal Line. Detour signs are installed as per the detour plan.
- The detour is east of Union Road via John Wise Line.
- A new detour will be put in place temporarily while the treatment plant crossing is being installed, the detour will use McDiarmid Line and Onieda Road.
- As the sanitary and storm sewers are installed, driveways will be temporarily impacted to accommodate new service connections. The contractor will make every reasonable effort to maintain access; however, some residents may experience restricted driveway access for up to a few days during work.
- The Contractor will provide residents with 1-2 days' notice if temporary driveway access restrictions are required.
- Walking path for pedestrians is on the east side Union Road marked by construction fence.
- The school bus pick-up and drop-off have been communicated by the bus company to affected users.
- Residents are asked to park in their driveways whenever possible and leave sufficient room on the roadway for construction traffic.

Construction Safety:

- Your safety is very important to us. Please respect the work zone.
- Please use caution when using the road or sidewalks in the construction zone and obey directions from traffic control.
- Parents are asked to ensure children stay clear of the construction area and equipment. Children should not enter the work zone and should be accompanied by a parent or guardian when near the construction area.
- Please be aware that there is a temporary water supply running on both sides of Union Road South of the pumping station up to Fingal Line. Also there is another temporary water line on Fowler Street from Church Street to Union Road, be careful when cutting grass near the line.
