## Fingal Construction Update # 7

### **Work Completed this week (Mar 16 - Mar 20):**

#### **Crew 1 & 2**

- Sanitary sewer progress North of Pump Station
- Crew has been experiencing poor soil conditions and has been coordinating with Engineers and Township to find a solution.

### **Waste Water Treatment Plant Update:**

- While Fingal construction works remain ongoing, the Wastewater Treatment Plant project continues to progress well. A photo has been included below to show the site's current conditions.



### **Work Planned for (Mar 23 - Mar 27):**

#### **Crew 1 & 2**

- Sanitary sewer and sanitary services will continue to progress North on Union Road



- To start bringing in soil to help mitigate the slope failure the project has been experiencing. We ask the Residents to please avoid construction area as much as possible and obey posted signage
- Test pits will be dug North and South of Fowler Street on Union Road, to investigate future soil condition

**Road Closure and Access:**

- Union road is closed to through traffic from Talbot Line to Fingal Line. Detour signs are installed as per the detour plan.
- The detour is east of Union Rd via John Wise Road
- As the sanitary sewer is installed, driveways will be temporarily impacted to accommodate new service connections. The contractor will make every reasonable effort to maintain access; however, some residents may experience restricted driveway access for up to a few days during work
- The Contractor will provide residents with 1-2 days' notice if temporary driveway access restrictions are required.
- Walking path for pedestrians is on the east side Union Road marked by snow fence
- The school bus pick-up and drop-off have been communicated by the bus company to affected users.
- Residents are asked to park in their driveways whenever possible and leave sufficient room on the roadway for construction traffic.

**Construction Safety:**

- Please use caution when using the road or sidewalks in the construction zone and obey directions from traffic control.
