Shedden Sanitary Sewer Construction Update #14



Road Construction



Sanitary Sewer Installation

Work Completed this week (June 23 - June 27):

- The contractor completed the installation of the 300mm sanitary sewer up to MH 6 (STA 0+380) which is approximately 70m north of Union Road/Fairground Street intersection.
- This included installation of MH 7 and MH 8 and 200mm sanitary sewer between MH 7 and MH 8.
- PDC sanitary services up to P/L follows main sewer installation.
- The construction of road follows the installation of sewer on daily basis.

Work Planned for (June 30 - July 04):

- The contractor will continue installation of the 300mm sanitary sewer form MH 6 towards MH 5 (STA 0+316) located approximately 90m south of Union Road/Waugh Street intersection.
- This also includes Installation of MH 6 and MH 5.
- Installation and testing of 200mm watermain at Waugh Street.
- Road construction will continue to follow Sewer installation on daily basis.



 The contractor is notifying residents of disturbances caused by construction as work passes affected residences.

Road Closure and Access:

- Union road is closed to through traffic from Talbot Line to Fingal Line. Detour signs are installed as per the detour plan.
- The detour is set east of Union Rd via John Wise Road
- Local traffic has access to properties
- School buses pick up and drop off location is at intersection of Union Road and Talbot Lane as per school bus provider plan
- Walking path for pedestrian is on grass area East of silt fence along Union Road
- Access to the soccer field parking area and residences south of the work zone will be maintained from the south side of Union Road.
- Contractor built temporary by-pass road behind the properties at east of Union Road, between Teetzel Street and Fairground Street. This road is to be used only by emergency vehicles.
- During construction works at the Union Road/Fairground Street intersection, All the emergency vehicles will be redirected to go through Fairground Campus Parking area.

Construction Safety:

- Your safety is very important to us. Please respect the work zone
- Please use caution when using the road or sidewalks in the construction zone and obey directions from traffic control.

Note:

 The contractor will observe the Canada Day holiday on Monday, June 30th, working instead on Tuesday, July 1st, 2025.
