Road Construction



Storm Sewer Installation

Work Completed this week (July 28 - July 31):

No work is scheduled for this Friday, August 1, 2025, as the PV-EX is observing the Civic Holiday.

- Contractor installed MH FST4, along with the 1050mm pipe towards MH FST2.
 They also installed MH FST2, MH FST3 and 600mm storm sewer between MH FST2 and MH FST3
- Currently, the crew is working on the 1050mm pipe from MH FST2 toward MH FST1, which is located at the intersection of Union Road and Teetzel Street. All this work is happening on the west side of Union Road.
- Following the sewer installation, road construction will involve placing Granular B. The granular A placement at the south end was completed on Wednesday, and the base asphalt is scheduled for placement on Tuesday of next week.

Work Planned for (Aug 04 - Aug 08):



- Continue installing 1050mm storm sewer toward Teetzel Street. After installing MH FST1, the contractor will continue with the 1050mm pipe toward MH FTS5, which is located at the intersection of Spicer and Union Road.
- Road construction will follow the sewer installation. The placement of the base asphalt for the south end of the Union Road work zone is scheduled for Tuesday. On the same day, the top asphalt will be placed on the Talbot Line/Union Road intersection.

Road Closure and Access:

- Union road is closed to through traffic from Talbot Line to Fingal Line. Detour signs are installed as per the detour plan.
- The detour is set east of Union Rd via John Wise Road
- Local traffic has access to properties
- Walking path for pedestrian is on grass area East of silt fence along Union Road
- Access to the soccer field parking area and residences south of the work zone will be maintained from the south side of Union Road.
- Contractor built temporary by-pass road behind the properties at east of Union Road, between Teetzel Street and Fairground Street. This road is to be used only by emergency vehicles.
- During construction works at the Union Road/Fairground Street intersection, All the emergency vehicles will be redirected to go through Fairground Campus Parking area.
- The Union Road/Talbot Line intersection is open for traffic.
