

COVID-19 VACCINATION VERIFICATION POLICY

FOR ALL CONTRACTORS THAT PERFORM WORK AT TOWNSHIP FACILITIES – EFFECTIVE OCTOBER 22, 2021

All Contractors/Sub-Contractors (hereinafter including all individual employees, agents or other representatives) must obtain and review the Township's COVID-19 Vaccination Verification Policy, which is applicable to Township workplaces. This policy requires any individual attending a Township workplace to submit proof of a full course of a Health Canada approved COVID-19 vaccination OR to provide the negative result of a rapid antigen test, or PCR test if available, taken within the immediately preceding forty-eight (48) hours, OR proof of a valid medical exemption, before being admitted to the Township workplace to perform work or deliver services. Each individual will be required to show proof of identification that corresponds to their proof of full vaccination. The Township will not keep a copy of the proof of vaccination or any other personal health information of the Contractor/Sub-Contractor. The Contractor/Sub-Contractor must ensure that all individuals attending a Township workplace to perform work or deliver services are aware of the policy and these requirements, to ensure that the individual arrives at the Township workplace with the proper documentation for screening. Any individual arriving at a Township workplace on behalf of a Contractor/Sub-Contractor that does not have the required documentation will be refused entry to the Township workplace and the Township will not pay any fee or cost to the Contractor for call-out or for the undelivered work or service where the Contractor/Sub-Contractor is turned away for failure to adhere to the Township's COVID-19 Vaccination Verification Policy.
