Payment Options: In person at Township office - cash, cheque, debit, credit card (a 2% surcharge is charged on all credit card transactions). Online bill payments and telebanking services through your financial institution. Afterhours cheque payments - we have a secure mailbox on the exterior of the office.

Bill Delivery: The Township of Southwold offers email delivery of property tax and utility bills. Forms are available on our website or a the Township office.

Water Bill Due Dates: 2023 Due Dates: April 28, July 31, October 31, 2023 and January 31, 2024. Payment arrangements can be made by contacting the Township office.

Preauthorized Payments - available Monthly and on Due Dates: Preauthorized payment (PAP) plans are available for tax installments and water utility bills. The monthly withdrawal is on the last business day of each month. Please visit our website, or visit the Township office to complete the form to enroll.

Streetlights: We rely on our residents to report when streetlights are out. Please call the office to report a streetlight concern. Thank you for your help!!

Garbage and Recycling Collection: The 2023 Collection Calendar is available on our website, or in print a the Township office. For missed pick-ups or service request, please contact the Township office, or fill out a request on our website. Please note the Garbage Collection Contractor is changing July 1, 2023 to GFL.

Drain Maintenance: We ask that property owners take time in early spring to look at areas on your property where municipal drains are located. Maintenance request submissions in advance of crop planting allows for efficiency in scheduling repairs. There is a drain maintenance request form on our website. If you have any questions on completing a request, please contact the Township office, or email drainage@southwold.ca.

Homeowners connected to Municipal water: It is the homeowner's responsibility to have the water shut-off valve (curbstop) accessible and visible to Municipal Staff at all times. This is so that it can be easily located in the case of an emergency or in the event that the water needs to be turned off at your home.

Dogs running at large: If you would like to request the pick-up of a stray dog, please contact the Township office. Please have a description and location of the dog. The dog must be confined for St. Thomas City Animal Services to pick it up.

Building Permits: The building department transitioned to a new e-permitting and inspection software, Cloudpermit, in 2022. For information on building permits, or on submitting one, please visit our website.

Half Load Season on Roads: is effective from March 1 to April 30, every year. The weight allowed is reduced on roads and bridges. Farm equipment, including mounted implements, are not subject to the reduced weight rules on "load reduced roads", Class B roads or bridges. However, heavy farm equipment owners are potentially liable if an overweight vehicle causes damage to a highway or bridge.

Municipal Parking By-Law: By-law 2002-4 prohibits parking of any motor vehicle on municipal streets between the hours of 3:00 AM and 5:00 AM year-round. Owners of vehicles that are in contravention of this by-law are subject to a fine. Any vehicles in contravention of this by-law are subject to removal at the owner's expense.

MPAC Property Assessment Notices: Update your mailing address online with MPAC. As a property owner, you will receive notices from the Municipal Property Assessment Corporation about your property's assessed value. If you want to change your mailing address, you can easily update it on www.mpac.ca.
