FIRE PREVENTION WEEK



This year's campaign, "Learn the Sounds of Fire Safety!" works to educate everyone about the different sounds that smoke and carbon monoxide alarms make. Knowing what to do when an alarm sounds will keep you and your family safe.

The Southwold Fire Department reminds you that when an alarm makes noises – a beeping sound or a chirping sound – you must take action! A constant BEEP means there is an emergency – get everyone out of the home immediately and call 9-1-1. A single CHIRP every 30 to 60 seconds means the batteries or alarms need replacing. Through our new website you can:

- Make a Service Request
- Pay a water bill, tax bill or an invoice with a credit card. A 2% Credit Card Surcharge will apply.
- Sign-up for preauthorized payments
- Sign-up to get your water or tax bills emailed to you
- Request a new or replacement 911 sign
- Subscribe to a page to receive the latest news and updates

REMINDER

Hydrant flushing and maintenance of the Southwold Distribution System will begin on October 12th for a 3 week duration.

During flushing, residents may experience a drop in pressure or discolouration of their water. Any disruption should be of a short duration and should only occur while mains in the area are being flushed. It is recommended that you turn on a cold water tap, preferably in a laundry tub, to flush out your service once flushing has occurred in your area. If there is an aerator on your tap, remove it prior to flushing your taps. Any questions, please call the Township office at 519-769-2010.
