ARE YOU ON THE VOTERS LIST? You can check if you are on the list by either dropping by, or contacting the Office. If you are not on the Voters List or the information about you is incorrect, you can attend the Municipal Office and fill out an application to amend or be added to the list. To save time, you can also download and complete the application form from the Township's website <u>www.southwold.ca</u>. Please note that you will be required to provide proof of identification.

WHAT HAPPENS IF I DON'T RECEIVE A VOTING KIT? If you do not receive a Voting Kit in the mail by the week of **October 10th ,2022** a "replacement kit" may be issued by attending the Municipal Office. Voter eligibility will be verified by the Clerk upon completion of a form and upon presentation of 2 pieces of identification.

WHAT HAPPENS IF I RECEIVE A VOTING KIT THAT IS NOT FOR ME? If you received a kit for someone who no longer lives at your address or is deceased, please return the kit to the Municipal office.

DO I HAVE TO MAIL MY BALLOT? No. Voters can drop off their completed ballot package at the Municipal Office during regular business hours Monday – Friday and up to 8 pm on Monday, October 24th, 2022. There is also a secure mail slot located by the main entrance for after-hours and weekend and drop-off.

DEADLINE FOR RETURNING THE BALLOT THROUGH REGULAR MAIL. October 13th, 2022 is the deadline set by Canada Post for mailing your return envelope so it will arrive at the Municipal Office by October 24th. Although to be sure it arrives on time, you can deliver it to the Municipal Office. Any ballots received after 8 pm on October 24th, 2022 whether at the Municipal Office or from Canada Post **CANNOT** be counted.

ELECTION RESULTS! You're invited to attend the Keystone Complex in Shedden on Monday October 24th, 2022 to view the results first hand. Doors open at 7 pm! The official results of the election will be posted on the Municipal Election Board at the Township Office and the Municipal Website as soon as possible after Voting Day.

REMINDERS

Hydrant flushing and maintenance of the Southwold Distribution System will continue until <u>October 28th, 2022</u>

During flushing, residents may experience a drop-in pressure. Any disruption should be of a short duration and should only occur while mains in the area are being flushed. It is recommended that you turn on a cold water tap, preferably in a laundry tub, to flush out your service once flushing has occurred in your area. If there is an aerator on your tap, remove it prior to flushing your taps.

A reminder to be careful what you flush.

Wet wipes, paper towels and facial tissues can clog pipes. We would like to remind residents not to flush wet wipes of any kind. Despite what some packaging says, wipes are not flushable. Paper towels and facial tissues also do not belong in the toilet. These items cannot be flushed because they do not break down like toilet paper does. If wipes, paper towels and facial tissues are flushed, they can cause blockages in pipes – which may lead to sewage overflows...
