EXCITING NEWS FOR THE TOWNSHIP OF SOUTHWOLD

We are thrilled to share some exciting news about the Shedden Sanitary Project, which marks a significant milestone in the growth and development of our community. The Township of Southwold, in partnership with the Province, has secured a generous \$28 million grant from the Housing Enabling Water Systems Fund to construct a new sanitary collection and treatment system for the Villages of Shedden and Fingal.

This transformative project will pave the way for new residential and commercial development, bringing immense benefits to our communities. The scope of the project includes several key components:

- Construction of a new Wastewater Treatment Facility in Shedden, located south of Corsley Park, is set to begin in Summer 2025.
- The construction of sanitary sewers from the Wastewater Plant to Talbot Line is already underway, with completion expected by September 2025.
- We will also be constructing sewers and a pumping station from Courtney Street to Talbot Line during Summer-Fall 2025.
- Finally, the construction of sewers and a pumping station in Fingal is scheduled for Spring-Fall 2026.

REMINDERS

SPRING HYDRANT FLUSHING

April 14th to May 7th the Ontario Clean Water Agency (OCWA) will be conducting spring flushing of hydrants.

During flushing, residents may experience a drop in pressure. Any disruption should be of a short duration and should only occur while mains in the area are being flushed. It is recommended that you turn on a cold-water tap, preferably in a laundry tub, to flush out your service once flushing has occurred in your area. If there is an aerator on your tap, remove it prior to flushing your taps.
