Reporting directly to the Lead Hand, the successful candidate will be responsible for the maintenance and patrolling of roads and roads-related infrastructure maintenance (e.g., sidewalks, bridges, guardrails) in accordance with Municipal objectives and Standard Operating Procedures from the hours of 3:00 a.m. to 7:00 a.m., Monday to Friday.

The ideal candidate will bring:

- Minimum Class DZ driver's license in good standing with Driver's Abstract.
- Experience operating equipment such as snowplows, highway transport trucks, dump trucks, leader, and 1-ton pickup trucks, with or without plow, considered an asset.
- Knowledge of construction and training in operation of equipment.
- Trained in Book 7 Short Duration Stops and Traffic Control considered an asset.
- Knowledge of WHMIS and the Occupational Health & Safety Act.
- Understanding of Health and Safety issues relevant to daily operations/equipment usage.
- Ability to work with limited supervision.
- Ability to work as part of a team.

This temporary, part-time position is unionized and runs from November 18, 2024, to March 14, 2025.

The rate of pay for this position will be commensurate with experience. This position is unionized and is not entitled to benefits, and the successful candidate is not eligible to participate in the Township's OMERS pension program.
