## Thomas Road Construction Update #12

### Work Completed this week (June 22 – June 26):

#### **Crew:**

- Crew continued building the road with granular from the tee intersection to the north limits of the job.
- Installed subdrain on both sides of Thomas Road.
- Installed string line for the new curb installation.



**Work Planned for (June 29 – July 3):**

**Crew:**

- Curb crew will begin pouring curbs Monday and Tuesday next week, please have your vehicles out of your driveway by 7:00a.m. Parking will be available at the north limits, the tee intersection and the south construction limit on Thomas Road.
- Once the curb is fully cured the contractor will provide gravel ramps so that residents can access their driveways.

### **Road Closure and Access:**

- Thomas road is closed to through traffic from Union Road south and north.
- Local traffic can still access properties. As construction approaches your property, adjust access accordingly.
- The school bus company has communicated any pick-up and drop-off adjustments directly with affected users.
- Your temporary mailbox is located at the Port Stanley Arena for mail delivery, see picture below for location reference. Any issues with mail deliveries please contact Canada Post directly.

### **Construction Safety:**

- Your safety is very important to us. Please respect the work zone
- Please use caution when using the road in the construction zone and obey directions from traffic control.
- Be aware that construction equipment and trucks may be entering and exiting the work zone.
- Parents are asked to ensure children stay clear of the construction area and equipment. Children should not enter the work zone and should be accompanied by a parent or guardian when near the construction area.
