Thomas Road Construction Update # 9

Work Completed this week (June 1 – June 5):

Crew:

- Completed the remaining amount of storm sewers to the north construction limit of Thomas Road.
- Installed Water Services up to property line.
- Pre-Excavated trenches for new Fire Hydrants.
- Continued building onto the road from the Trout Farm towards the tee intersection.



Work Planned for (June 8 – June 12):

Crew:

- The second crew will continue building the road with granular past the trout farm and start working up to the tee intersection on Thomas Road.
- Install new Fire Hydrants.
- Start installing watermain pipe towards the new PRV water chamber, commissioning the new watermain prior to connecting.





Road Closure and Access:

- Thomas road is closed to through traffic from Union Road south and north.
- Local traffic can still access properties. As construction approaches your property, adjust access accordingly.
- The school bus company has communicated any pick-up and drop-off adjustments directly with affected users.
- Your temporary mailbox is located at the Port Stanley Arena for mail delivery, see picture below for location reference. Any issues with mail deliveries please contact Canada Post directly.

Construction Safety:

- Your safety is very important to us. Please respect the work zone
- Please use caution when using the road in the construction zone and obey directions from traffic control.
- Be aware that construction equipment and trucks may be entering and exiting the work zone.
- Parents are asked to ensure children stay clear of the construction area and equipment. Children should not enter the work zone and should be accompanied by a parent or guardian when near the construction area.
