A reminder to be careful what you flush



Wet wipes, paper towels and facial tissues can cause major failures at the wastewater treatment plant. Resident should not flush wet wipes of any kind. Despite what some packaging says, wipes are not flushable. Paper towels and facial tissues also do not belong in the toilet, since they do not break down like toilet paper does. If wipes, paper towels and facial tissues are flushed, they can severely damage the sanitary infrastructure, which may lead to sewage overflows, costly repairs, and ultimately, higher user rates
