



Dear Homeowner/Tenant,

Please be advised that your water service will be temporarily shut off on **October 28<sup>th</sup>, 2020.**

**This will happen between the hours of 8:00am and 6:00pm.**

**Please note the following:**

“PRIOR TO THIS, PLEASE DRAW SUFFICIENT WATER INTO CONTAINERS FOR USE DURING THE INTERRUPTION AND IF POSSIBLE, TURN OFF THE MAIN SHUT OFF VALVE AT THE METER IN YOUR BUILDING TO PREVENT ACCIDENTAL USAGE. IF SHUTTING THE VALVE IS IMPOSSIBLE OR INCONVENIENT, AND YOU HAVE AN AUTOMATIC WATER SOFTENER, PLEASE PUT THAT WATER SOFTENER ON BY-PASS TO PREVENT IT FROM RECYCLING DURING THE CLEANING PROCESS.

IF YOU HAVE A FIRE SPRINKLER SYSTEM, IT WOULD BE ADVISABLE FOR YOU TO NOTIFY YOUR INSURANCE COMPANY OF THE DOWN TIME.

WHEN FULL PRESSURE IS RESTORED, A WATER TAP SHOULD BE OPENED IN THE BASEMENT AT THE LAUNDRY TUB TO FLUSH THE SYSTEM BEFORE REGULAR WATER CONSUMPTION IS RESUMED.

RESIDENTS ARE ADVISED TO CHECK THE CONDITION OF THEIR WATER PRIOR TO LAUNDERING.”
